A county community where all residents are safe from gun violence.

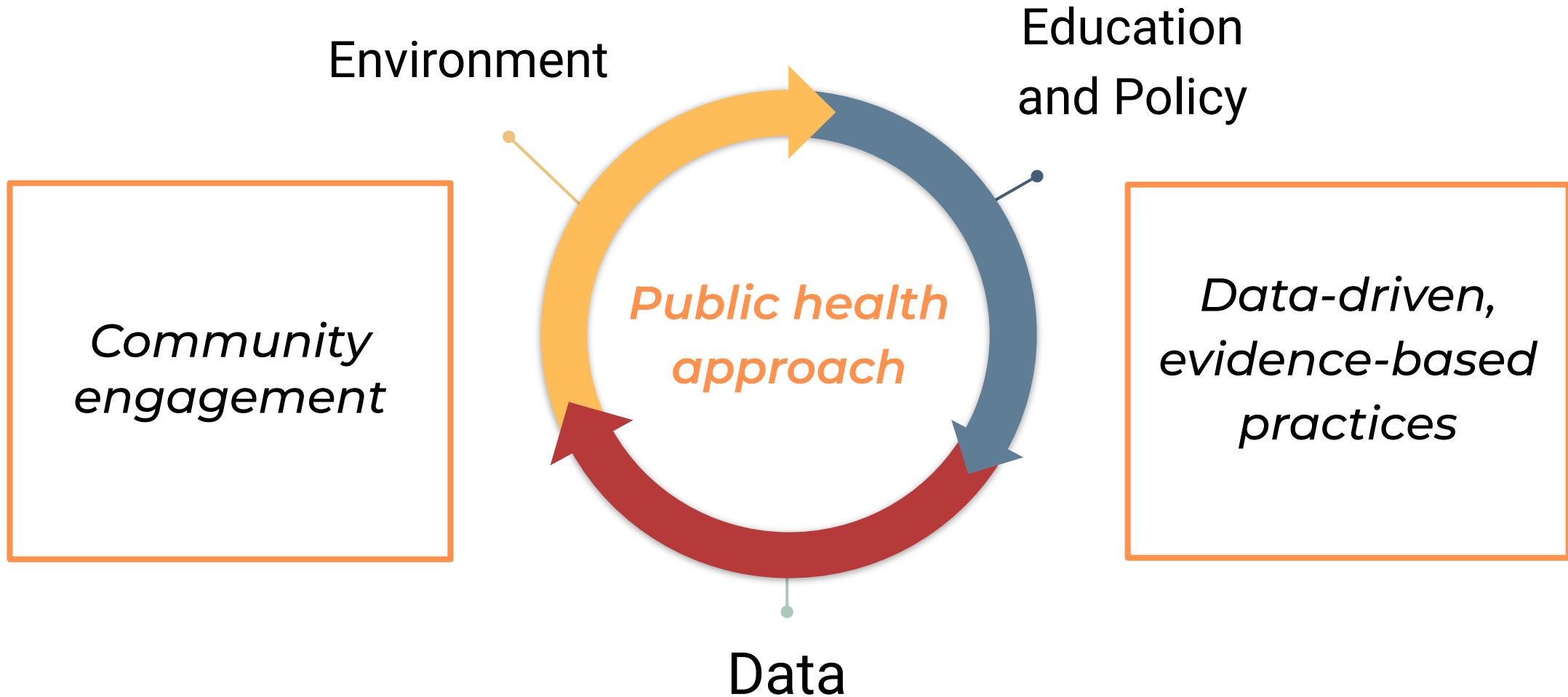

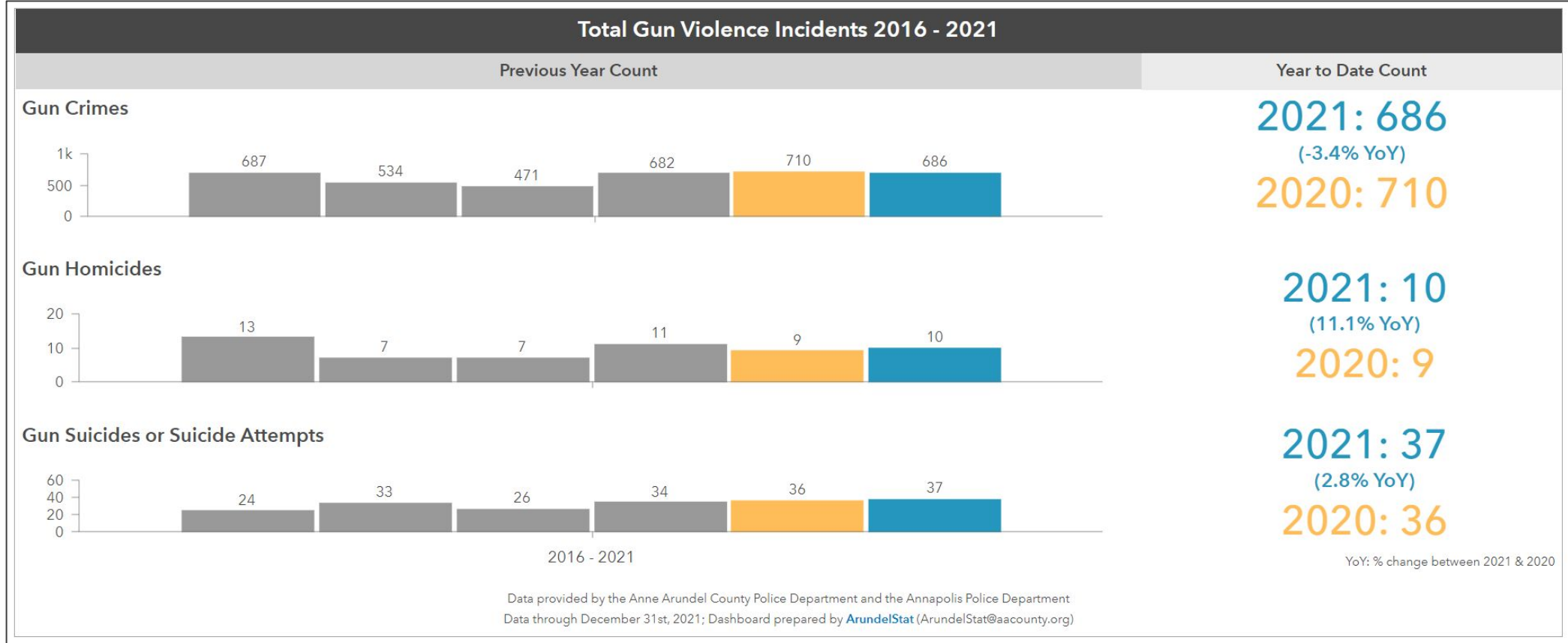

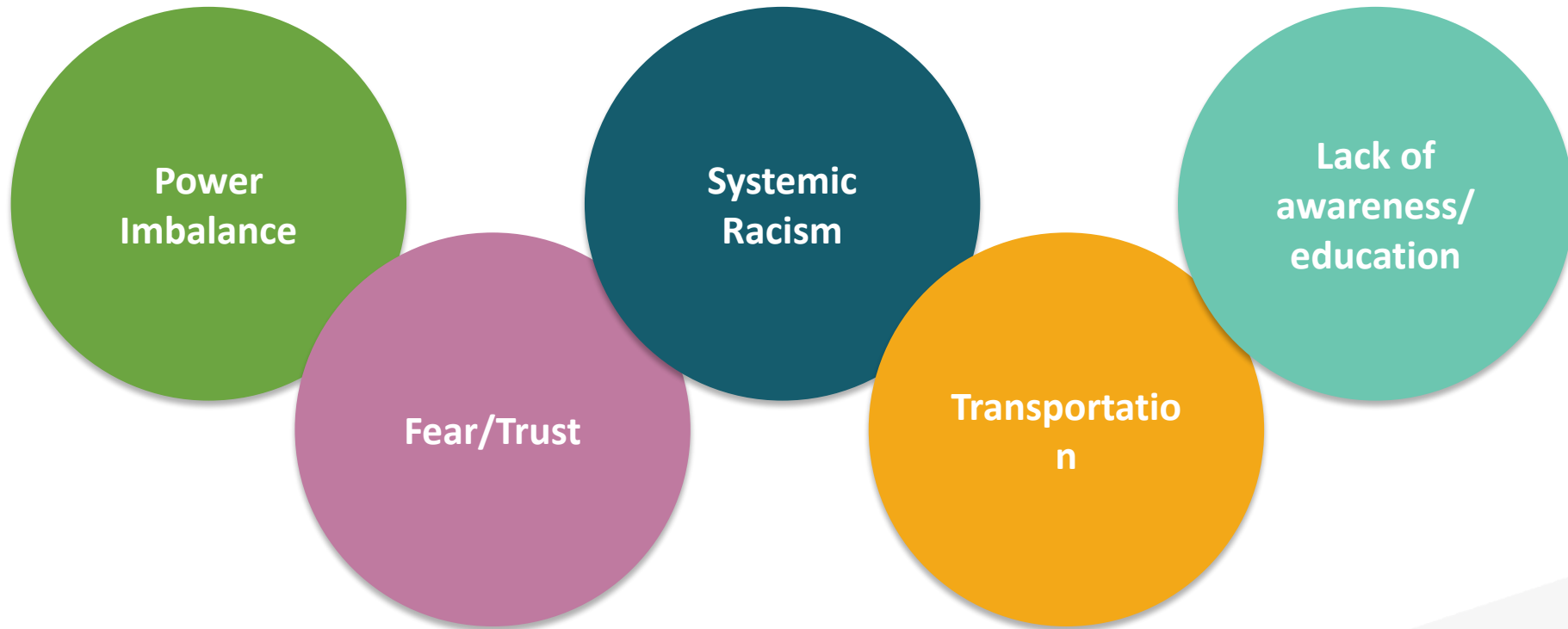
